Each student (9-12) must carry a minimum of seven classes per semester; these may include any of the electives listed below for your grade. Any course may be taken any year after it is first offered if the pre-requisites are met. No more than one physical education course per semester may be counted toward a student's seven classes.

Exemptions will be granted to seniors for the following reasons:

- 1) Students who are taking any three of the following weighted courses: AP courses, Anatomy & Physiology, Calculus, PACC courses, and Physics.
- 2) For the purpose of this policy, Youth Apprenticeship (YA) program participation will count as one class;
- 3) No one will be permitted to engage in more than 1 YA program in any semester.
