WISCONSIN PARENTAL CHOICE PROGRAM - Application Period February 1 - April 20, 2016

The Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP) allows families within the income requirements to apply for a tuition voucher. If your child is entering school in grades K, 1, or 9 and is selected by the state, he/she would receive free tuition to attend Assumption Catholic Schools during the 2016-2017 school year. **2016-2017 Adjusted Gross Income limits are shown below.**

- If you meet the above income limits and wish to apply for the WPCP Program, complete an online application at <http://sms.dpi.wi.gov/wpcp-statewide>.
- To be considered for the program, **applications must be submitted online during the application period of February 1-April 20, 2016.** Late applications will not be accepted.
- After you submit your online application you will be required to submit residency documentation and income document to the ACS Administrative Office by **4 p.m., Monday, April 20th**. The ACS Administrative Office is located in the Assumption building at 445 Chestnut St., Wisconsin Rapids, WI 54494. Documentation can only be accepted at our Administrative Office.
- We recommend turning in your required documentation before the deadline date to allow adequate time for verification. After the **deadline date of April 20th**, we are not able to accept any resubmitted or corrected documentation due to program rules. Your online application is considered incomplete until all the required and eligible documentation is turned into the ACS Administrative Office by the deadline date and time. All information is kept confidential.

St. Joseph Tuition Grant Program - Application Period February 10 - April 15, 2016.

The St. Joseph Tuition Grant Program is an Assumption Catholic Schools financial award based on verified need. We invite you to apply for the St. Joseph Tuition Grant if you feel your family has financial need. **Families must apply each year to be considered for a grant.**

- To apply, please complete the Tuition Grant Application. Applications are available with online enrollment forms, on our Assumption Catholic Schools Website, and in the Finance Office located in the Assumption building at 445 Chestnut St.
- Children must be enrolled in Assumption Catholic Schools in order to apply for the tuition grant.
- To verify reported income, you must submit the top two pages of your Federal Tax Return (1040) or W2's.
- Funds are limited, therefore, it is important that **we receive your application and supporting documentation (Federal tax return 1040, W2's or other proof of income)** by the due date. **Application deadline is April 15, 2016.**
- Families will be notified of the amount awarded by the end of June. **All information is kept confidential.**

SCRIP Tuition Credit Program

Assumption Catholic School provides the SCRIP Program to allow all families the opportunity to earn credit towards their child's tuition. The **rebate profit** from your purchases is divided up: 70% of the rebate profit is applied to your ACS tuition account and 30% of the rebate profit is used for school operating expenses.
