Tuition 2025-2026

As a part of the registration process, all families will select a payment plan in the FACT system. Options include pay in full by September 15 or April 15. Pay monthly in 10 payments starting September 15 ending June 15.

Families that have WPCP or SNSP should select the pay in full by April 15 option. Vouchers will be applied by August 30.

Hot Lunch Fees will be charged separately. Free/reduced lunch applications will be available at the beginning of the school year. Additional charges may arise during the school year and are collected by each school. Included are field trips, snack fees, childcare, mission or service projects, AP Testing, special courses, international travel, etc.
