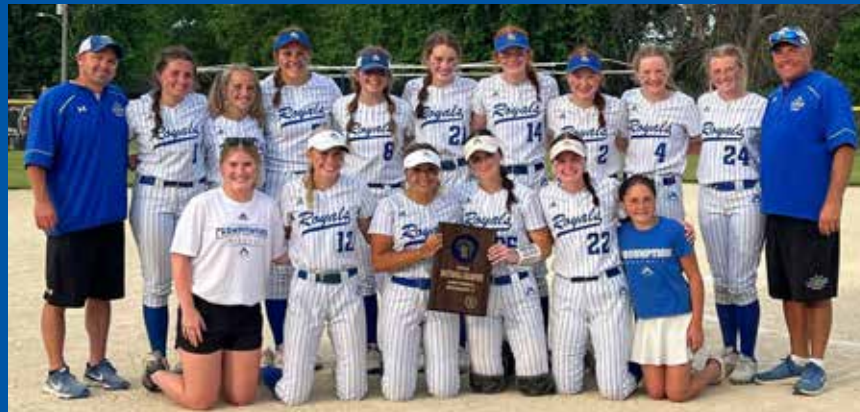
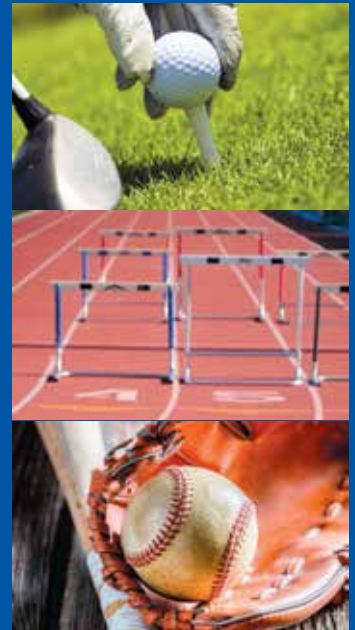

Assumption High School was founded in 1951 as Tri-City Catholic High School, and was housed for three years at Our Lady Queen of Heaven School in Wisconsin Rapids. In 1954, the existing school was dedicated as Assumption High School. The school operates under the auspices of the Diocese of LaCrosse and has the following mission statement: "To inspire excellence and personal growth, grounded in Catholic principles and tradition". Therefore, Assumption's philosophy is to assist the individual student in developing the knowledge and skills which are needed for responsible living.
