Friday Dress Down Days

Friday's throughout the school year students are allowed to dress in casual attire.

Students can wear clothes outside of the normal dress code (all modesty dress code requirements still apply) On dress down days, students are allowed to wear jeans or joggers or athletic track/training pants/shorts. No leggings, jeggings, pajama pants, or yoga pants. Jeans cannot have holes or frays and must remain at waist level (no sagging, low-rise, low-riding pants). Shirts/sweatshirts can have any print or design, avoiding any reference to drugs/alcohol/weapons, inappropriate sayings or offensive political designs.

Students interested in participating in these Friday Dress Down Days should return the dress down fee by September 5th, 2024.

\$10 for middle school students \$25 for high school students

*Note: Dressing down on Friday's is optional, and paying the fee is not required.

Those students/families not wanting to participate can opt out and students can just wear normal dress code.





