



## VICE INFIDELITY & IT'S CONSEQUENCES

Infidelity or unfaithfulness is the weakness to not be faithful to one's commitments and promises.

**Consequences of Infidelity** 

Hurt Feelings: People get upset when you break promises or are not loyal.

**Broken Trust:** It's hard for others to trust you again if you are unfaithful.

**Distance from God:** Not being faithful can make you feel further away from God's love.

#### WHAT WE CAN LEARN FROM ST. PETER

#### St. Peter's Denial (Matthew 26:69-75):

Peter, despite his earlier proclamation of loyalty to Jesus, denied knowing Him three times during Jesus' trial, out of fear and self-preservation. This act demonstrated a momentary lapse in fidelity to Jesus.

## St. Peter's Repentance and Love (John 21:15-17):

But afterwards, he was very sorry and he declared three times that he loved Jesus.

We make mistakes. We say and do things we regret. Let's go to the sacrament of Confession and renew our love for Jesus like St. Peter did.

Telling lies.



- 7. Act of Thanksgiving and Resolution




#### ST. JOHN CHRYSOSTOM

John's father died soon after his birth and he was raised by his mother.

He became the Archbishop of Constantinople and was famous for his tremendously **powerful** sermons and homilies, especially when he preached against the rich, their extravagant parties and their ignoring of the poor.

The empress got so upset at St. John that she had the emperor banish him from the city. But soon after, an earthquake shook the city and she soon regretted her decision. She feared further angering God and the people and had the Archbishop brought back to the city.

Think of some different scenarios.






#### Matthew 25: 19-21

The one who had received five talents came forward bringing the additional five.


He said, 'Master, you gave me five talents. See, I have made five more.'





Lord God, You didn't run at the first sign of chaos or difficulty.


You showed us how to be FAITHFUL, sacrificial, loving and truthful.
