- Kerry Meinel gave an update on enrollment. See attached for the breakdown of numbers at each school. Enrollment is lower this year compared to last year at this time.
- The DPI will release the Accountability Report Cards in November for the 2023-2024 school year. ACS does not participate in an all school report card. The scores reported only reflect our WPCP participants if they opted to take the required assessments. The School Report Card will be sent home and information posted on our website. - Mr. Minter introduced a draft of revenue and expenses for ACS when it is finalized, it will be shared with all.
- School Updates: Mrs. France attended a Marawood Leadership Conference today with 6 high school students who were selected by the staff. They were required to develop a smart goal and action plan. They have decided to create a student academic committee and present their ideas and concerns to the high school staff academic committee.
- Mrs. Kuhn said that St. Vincent de Paul is off to a good start. We are blessed with a dedicated staff and supportive parents. Fr. Schaller mentioned that Mass and confessions have gone very smoothly. He was very proud of the students.
- Mrs. Bruley shared that Our Lady Queen of Heaven has received new windows and shades in the classrooms, drop ceilings and new lights, fresh paint, and new partitions in the restrooms. In December, the basement will be receiving an upgrade and next summer the playground will be receiving an upgrade.
