What is Cub Scouting all about?

Activities: Adventure field trips, camping, family outings, STEM, outdoor fun, games with friends and year-round excitement!

Costs: Anyone in grades K-5 can join regardless of ability to pay. See the front of this flyer for annual fees. Financial assistance is available at Samoset.org/aid. Fundraising activities such as the annual fall popcorn sale are also available to help a Scout earn their own way while learning valuable sales skills.

How often do Cub Scouts Meet? Typically, 2-3 times a month for about an hour in a group called a den with 6-8 other youth the same age. They then meet once a month with all grades K-5 age-groups at a pack meeting where they showcase what they learned at their den meetings, receive their earned achievements and often have other pack meeting activities. The day and time of the den meetings is coordinated by the parents in the den.



Benefits that your Scout will enjoy Making lifelong friends, outdoor activities, field trips, and earning beltloops & badges for learning new things. Making a pinewood derby car out of a block of wood and racing it with others in a friendly competition. Help other people through community service projects. Trying a new activity like a STEM project, boulder climbing, swimming, archery, campfire building, hiking, camping, snow sports, launch a rocket, and more all while having fun! Cub Scouting is family focused.
